

Non-Fingerprint Conviction Information Name Check Request

All individuals who wish to conduct research in Illinois schools during attendance periods are now required to pass a criminal background check run by the Illinois State Police. The criminal background check returns data on any convictions an individual has had in the state of Illinois. Individuals who have been convicted of criminal offenses that would prevent them from receiving teacher certification in Illinois will be barred from doing research in the schools. Examples of such offenses are first degree murder, attempted first degree murder, class X felonies, or certain narcotics or sexual offenses. Some school districts require a copy of the criminal background check result. Except for the school districts that require this information, all background check results will be kept confidential and will not be shared with any other firms, organizations, or agencies. You will receive a copy of the result for your own records.
