Introducing the research of two new Faculty in the College of Education.

The presentation will briefly describe research and development in three related areas:

‡Learning Ecologies

The teacher as designer of learning environments; teacher documentation in e-learning; and the micro dynamics of learning or the kinds of 'knowledge processes' or epistemological moves that learners make.

‡Social and Learner Diversity

How social and learner diversity is conceived, and the practical logistics of negotiating diversity in a learning setting.

‡Representational Resources

The multimodality of representational functions (written, oral, visual, audio, gestural, tactile, spatial); synaesthesia or learning by crossing modes; the 'grammar' of new media environments including the emerging 'semantic web'; and pedagogies for new literacies or 'multiliteracies'.
