SAMPLE STUDENT CONSENT LETTER (ELEMENTARY SCHOOL STUDENTS)
(May be read to students)

Hi! We are here from the University of Illinois to do a project in your classroom about making maps. If you do this project, you will spend 15 minutes each day for two weeks of your regular math class time learning how to make maps. We will videotape these lessons so that we can look at them later. You and your classmates will also go on a field trip to the University of Illinois Library to look at maps, and at the end of this project, you will each be making your own maps of your school building.

Your participation in this project is voluntary-this means that you can decide whether or not you want to do this project. If you want to stop doing the project at any time, you can stop. The videotapes and all the other information from this project will be kept private and secure. The videotapes will be coded to remove your names and will be erased after the project is finished. This project won't go on your school record or count toward your math grade. If you decide not to do this project, you will do other math work during the time your classmates learn about maps.
