- ▶ Students should enroll in MATH 103, MUS 130 or 133, and ART140 in the fall if these courses have not been successfully completed. (They will not fit in the Spring Schedule because of CI 420.)
- ▶ ECE majors must complete the 24 hours of pre-toddler experience offered in EDPR 250 (section EC).
- ▶ CI 420 requires students be available for the practicum portion of this course Monday – Friday, 8am – noon.
- ▶ There is comfortable room for 4 additional General Education or Area of Concentration courses in YEAR I. If more than that is needed, summer school needs to be considered since there is no room in YEAR II for any additional coursework.
- ▶ All required professional education courses in YEAR I must be passed to be eligible to continue into the clinical year.
