*Fall 2009 or Spring 2010*

**CI 405                      Intro Into Teaching Elementary Age Children                      2 hours**

- Taken fall or spring semester
- 30 hours of participation in local schools, grades K-8 or specialized classrooms within 60 radius of campus
- Participation schedule is determined by the cooperating teacher and student
- Unsupervised by UIUC but cooperating teacher completes evaluation form
- Students follow UIUC calendar

*The required professional education courses must be passed to be eligible to continue into year two.*

**YEAR TWO**

*Fall 2010*

**CI 406                      Theory and Practice in Elementary Teaching I                      4 hours**

- Experiences in local schools, grades K-8, within 60 mile radius C-U
- All day Tuesday and Wednesday each week
- Placements in Balanced Calendar Schools have interim placement during intersession
- Students follow UIUC calendar
- Supervised by UIUC clinical faculty and grad students

### Spring 2011

#### **EdPr 432                      Educational Practice in Elementary Education                      8 hours**

- Student teachers follow the calendar of their assigned school
- Student teachers will be enrolled in UIUC classes during student teaching: CI 407, CI 447, CI 476
- Professional Education courses (CI 407, CI 447, CI 476) will meet online, locally, and off campus throughout the semester
- UIUC course work will be taken concurrently with student teaching and may involve some evening classes
- Elementary teacher education students have 4 options for Spring Student Teaching: Local Traditional Calendar (TCS), Local Balanced Calendar (BCS), selected off campus schools in Northwest Suburbs, and CPS.

#### **Balanced Calendar - Local Area School**

*Placements are in Champaign, Thomasboro, Danville*

- Student teachers begin their classroom placements at the beginning of January 2011 with the cooperating teaching school calendar, which is about 2 weeks before UIUC classes begin.
- BCS have a 2 or 3-week Spring Intercession depending on the district calendar.
- Student teachers meet 7 Fridays throughout the semester on campus.

#### **Traditional Calendar - Local Area School**

*Placements are in communities within a 60-mile commuting radius of C-U.*

- Student teachers begin their classroom placement during the first week of UIUC instruction.
- Student teachers follow the Spring break of their assigned school.
- Student teachers meet 7 Fridays throughout the semester on campus.

#### **Off-Campus Placements**

*Placements are in selected Northwest Suburb and Chicago Public Schools.*

- Student teachers begin their classroom placement during the first week of UIUC instruction.
- Student teachers follow the Spring break of their assigned school.
- Student teachers meet 7 Fridays throughout the semester on campus.
