The Illinois Assessment Consequences Evaluation (IACE) project lab in the Department of Educational Psychology seeks a three-quarter time Visiting Project Coordinator who will be responsible for coordinating all aspects of a four year project to review the Illinois State Board of Education large scale assessment and accountability system. The project involves the development and administration of a survey to a representative sample of schools across the state and a technical examination of assessment equating, managing communication across project team members, and supervision of graduate students. The Project Coordinator's responsibilities will include project communication, coordination of survey activities including planning and scheduling survey administration, assisting in survey instrument development including the identification of pilot sites and pilot administration, overall data analysis and reporting, and day to day supervision of research assistants.

Qualifications: Graduate degree (MS or Ph.D.) in Evaluation, Assessment, Measurement or related area. Candidate with experience working in public schools and quantitative and mixed methods research skills preferred.

Salary: Commensurate with experience.

This is a grant-funded, three-quarter time (may become full time at a future date) visiting academic professional position to begin as soon as possible to March 1, 2010. This position if fully funded by an external grant and continuation of the appointment beyond the grant end date is contingent upon successful acquisition of additional external funding.
