**Architecture MARCH, Journalism MS, Library and Information Science MS, and Social Work MSW receive base-rate waivers only (\$11,612 for Fall, Spring Waivers and \$15,745 for Fall, Spring, Summer Waivers).*

**Please note that if the assistantship/fellowship stipend is less than \$18,912, the applicant will need to provide additional proof of funding.*

Students must show proof of funding for one year, as well as the intent for funding for the full length and cost of the program. The funding amounts for which the student must provide proof of funding are listed above by admission term.

Example: If a student is admitted for Fall 2010, he/she must provide an original bank statement with a balance of at least \$43,790. His/Her sponsor must also provide a Declaration & Certification of Finance Form or Letter of Sponsorship verifying that he/she will be sponsored for the full length and cost of the program. Please note that students with personal funds do not have to provide a Declaration and Certification of Finance Form (but do have to provide original bank statements).
