POSITION: Assistant/Associate Professor in Human Resource Education with specialization in human resource development. This is a tenure accruing position.

STARTING DATE: August 16, 2008

QUALIFICATIONS: Applicants should have:

- An earned doctorate from an accredited institution, with an emphasis in human resource development.
- A record of scholarly productivity in the field of human resource development exhibited through research, publication, and grant activity in human resource development.
- Evidence of preparation to teach graduate courses in human resource development.
- Ability and interest in advising and mentoring graduate students.
- Demonstrated leadership in human resource development professional associations.
- A thorough understanding of human resource development philosophy, theories, and curriculum.
- Interest and/or experience in national and international dimensions of human resource development and international teaching opportunities.
- Interest and/or experience in teaching in an online environment.
- Experience in advanced-level human resource development practice through professional engagement and/or applied research activities.
- Interest and ability to work on collaborative research and development.
- The ability to work effectively with diverse individuals and groups at the university level as well as in the public and private sectors.

RESPONSIBILITIES: The successful candidate will be expected to make the following contributions to the graduate programs within the Department of Human Resource Education:

- Design and teach courses in human resource development at the graduate level, with an emphasis on the integration of theory, research, and application in a variety of organizational and institutional learning situations in the private and public sectors.
- Plan and implement a program of research and grant writing related to human resource development.
- Advise master and doctoral students specializing in human resource development.
- Serve in leadership capacities and play an active role in human resource development professional associations.
- Pursue external funding opportunities through grants and contracts.
- Collaborate with College faculty on key strategic initiatives in areas related to education in small urban communities, eLearning, STEM, and international education and development.
- Serve on Department, College of Education, and campus committees, and fulfill various other assignments consistent with an academic role.

RANK: This is a regular, full-time tenure track position. Appointment at the rank of Assistant or Associate Professor will be based on the qualifications and experience of the candidate.

SALARY: Competitive, depending on scholarly record and experience.
