- Review three to six 250-400 word abstracts and return recommendations to the COEGSC Planning Committee by the established deadline.
- Reviewers will be provided with a predetermined review guide. Each reviewer will be completed anonymously.
- Reviews will be completed electronically.
- Training is **MANDATORY** for all new reviewers. If you have reviewed for the conference in previous years, you **DO NOT** have to attend training.

Benefits:

- Provide peers with feedback on how they can improve/advance their research projects.
- Supports the program committee in making sure that the most outstanding research is presented.
- Provides an excellent opportunity to experience the review process.
