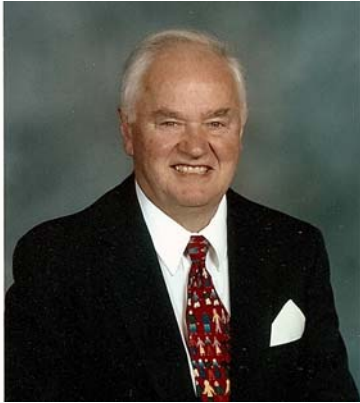

Most of the benefits of higher education are non-market private and social benefits beyond earnings. Poor information about these and about their economic value contributes to market failure and underinvestment. One result is the privatization and vocationalization trend in higher education. Another is evidence of massive national skill deficits and widening inequality. Higher education policy is not facing these and other major implications of lack of attention to outcomes and of higher education market failure.
