

Community College Teaching and Learning (CCTL) Master of Education (Ed.M.) Program (online)

Effective for students entering after July 1, 2007

The Master of Education (Ed.M.) with a concentration in Community College Teaching and Learning (CCTL) is designed to increase the teaching effectiveness of community college faculty and build the instructional leadership of supervisory personnel. The degree in the Department of Human Resource Education is earned through the Graduate College by students who satisfactorily complete 36 hours of course work beyond the baccalaureate degree. At least twelve hours of course work must be at the 500 level.

Students admitted to the online Ed.M. degree program should fulfill the following minimum requirements. Any deviation from this plan must be approved by the Online Programs Coordinator.
