The Master of Education (Ed.M.) with a concentration in Human Resource Development (HRD) is designed for individuals currently working in or aspiring to human resource development positions in a variety of organizational sectors. The degree in the Department of Human Resource Education is earned through the Graduate College by students who satisfactorily complete 36 hours of course work beyond the baccalaureate degree. At least twelve hours of course work must be at the 500 level.
