

## Fast Groupings in Elluminate

Sending 30 or even 100 students into the breakout room within 30 seconds can be a big challenge. Here is a good practice provided by EPS 415 Su 08 course, which gives instructors an example to group students effectively.

### 1. Tell students to change their display name

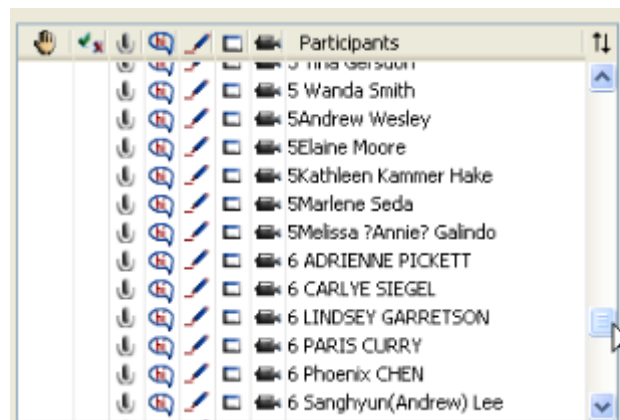
- (1) Log-in to Elluminate
- (2) Click on "Profile"
- (3) Click on "Edit"
- (4) Change Display Name. Here we can add group number before name.
- (5) Click "Save" and go back to "My Elluminate"
- (6) Join the Live! Session now.

### 2. Grouping students

When course is running, you can see students' name are listed in the numeric order, therefore, we can select students according to group numbers quickly, and send them to a specific room.



Because Elluminate will sort students' name by alphabetic or numeric order, you can create your personal grouping code schemes for multiple groupings .
